- The "Product" named on this permission form is the only item GELC staff is authorized to use on your child.
- All OTC medications must be in the original container with the child's first and last name clearly labeled.
- GELC staff may not apply any "Product" to open wounds or broken skin. If your child develops a rash with open wounds or broken skin, a written order by a prescribing physician is required. In such case, a Medical Administration Form will be used.
- If this "Product" is expired, the parent will be given the "Product" to take home for disposal.
